The above information was given orally to congregations attending services on Sunday 5th November 2017 and is being repeated through the Parish Notices for the remaining Sundays of the statutory notice period up to and including 10th December 2017.

Mothers' Union: 16 days of activism against gender-based violence

The worldwide Mothers' Union is currently holding its annual campaign against all forms of violence which are gender-related. Our parish's branch of the Mothers' Union therefore encourages you to support this period of sixteen days of activism, in which the focus is on combating the stigma surrounding gender-based violence, lifting the shame placed on survivors, and shifting the blame from victim to perpetrator.

During services today we are therefore urged to link hands with one another to represent our unity in ending gender-based violence; to reach out hands to represent our connection with those around the world affected by, or campaigning against gender-based violence; and to lift hands up, as a sign of prayer for an end to such violence.
